

2016 Premier Shows & Workshops

Outline:

Counterworld is a youth dance project that has already had one very successful production with over 150 students and dance school students on the Sunshine Coast. It is choreographed by LissaJane Dance artistic director, Melissa Lanham and is performed with the principal dancers from "Vincent" – which is having its Australian Premier at the Adelaide Fringe Festival 2016.

Being a participant in the project will allow students to develop skills in contemporary dance, dance theatre skills, improvisation, choreography, repertoire, class work, stylized movement, task work and partnering. LissaJane Dance always focuses on safe dance practices and so all of the work taught keeps these practices at the forefront.

Participation:

Counterworld is being offered to high school aged students within South Australia and to university dance students. It is open to both men and women, and as a participant you will be part of:

1. Several rehearsals and workshops held at your dance school, or a nominated dance school in your area
2. Combined blocking rehearsals and dress rehearsals
3. Combined master classes and warm ups with the principal dancers of Vincent
4. Students above 18 years of age will receive an official "Artist Pass" to the Adelaide Fringe which enables them to partake in the artistic lounges and venues of the festival*
5. 4 live performances of Counterworld at the Odeon Theatre as part of the Vincent Premier

Rehearsal Dates:

Rehearsal dates will be through the Christmas holidays.

Individual Rehearsal Weeks: 11th – 15th January & 18th – 22nd January.

These dates will be 1 day per school, per week, subject to change with bookings.

Group Blocking Rehearsals: 16th & 17th January and 23rd & 24th January (*Location TBC*)

Final Blocking Rehearsal: 21st February, 2016 at the Odeon Theatre, Norwood

Performance Dates: 12th & 13th March, 2016 at the Odeon Theatre, Norwood

Cost:

Participants cost will be \$100 per person, all inclusive. Payments can be made online. Students will also receive a t-shirt for the duration of their rehearsals.

Tickets:

Tickets to these Vincent – Counterworld performances will be available through FringeTix or at www.adelaidefringe.com.au and students are invited and encouraged to bring family, friends and colleagues to be part of this fantastic opportunity. There is a 15:30 Matinee and a 19:30 Evening show.

*Adelaide Fringe Artist Passes are valid for participants 18 years and over as they permit access to fringe garden artist bars and show admissions within the GOUD.
